

The auction is a major fundraiser for NERBA! Money raised supports the organization so we can continue to host this event for years to come. It is our goal to ensure a smooth, stress-free auction process. To achieve this, firm guidelines have been carefully established and we ask that all members read and adhere to them as written.

CONSIGNED ITEMS:

May 29, 2024 DEADLINE DATE! Full descriptions of buttons and/or button related items and desired starting bids must be submitted to auction chair. There can be no exceptions! Nothing can be accepted after this date.

- Consignors must be a member of CT, MA, ME, NY, NH, RI or VT button societies.
- Each lot must have a minimum value of \$25.
- There is a three lot maximum per member.
- Auction chair reserves the right to reject items not deemed acceptable.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND items to be auctioned. If your items are accepted, the auction chair will provide you a Lot # (s) and more information about submitting your lot (s).

TERMS: 75% of hammer price goes to the consignor. 25% goes to NERBA. Checks will be mailed to consignors by July 28, 2024.

DONATED ITEMS:

- All items donated will be accepted at the chairman's discretion. 100% goes to NERBA.
- There is no limit to the amount of buttons/button related items donated.
- There is no deadline for donation.

NOTE: Donors who submit items by May 29th, 2024 will be included on the auction list. Otherwise, donors names will be verbally mentioned by the auctioneer.



Division I

2. Cl. 10-5.6, Various. Steel cups. Steel button lover. \$15-10-5.

Division III

- 3. Cl. 2-2.2, 25 Any size. Kutani. Label back types and back marks. Double shanks allowed. Lynne Drury. \$10-7-5.
- 4. Cl. 6-3.8, 30 Any size. Moonglows. Surface colors, sizes, OMEs, DFs, and face designs all worth points. Label salient features. Katrinka Quirk in honor of Vicky MacTavish. \$15-10-5.
- 5. Cl. 10-3.3, 20 Any size. Soft cast pewter specialized to Christina pewter. Friends of Thelma Nichols in honor of her work as the new NERBA's first treasurer. \$30-20-15.
- 6. Cl. 23-11, 20 Any size. Studio buttons assorted. Must have five buttons made by Dot or Phil Linley. The Linley buttons must be signed on the back, and all buttons must be labeled as to the studio artist. Laurel Durso in memory of Dot Linley. \$15-10-5.

Division IX

- 7. Cl. 1-0, 25 Any size. Celluloid assorted. Belknap Button Club in honor of our new members. \$25-15-10.
- 8. Cl. 1-0 through 15-5, 20 Any Size, LIMITED. Assorted materials specialized to red on the button face. 50% or more of the face must be red. Include tints, shades and hues of reds, but do not include pink which is a different listed NBS color. Limited to clubs, or state societies that are the only club, as of this publication. This is a group award and learning opportunity. Club members should pool their buttons to create the tray. Crescent Club of Massachusetts in honor of all button clubs. \$20-20-20.
- 9. Cl. 1-0 through 15-5, 25 Any size. Assorted materials specialized to peacocks. Gretchen Gauthier in honor of all my judging room volunteers because I'm proud as a peacock for all your work. \$25-15-10.

- 10. Cl. 1-1.1, 25 Any size. Hollow body specialized to glow bubbles. Points given for each different color of glow or combinations of glow. George Gauthier in memory of Joy Gauthier. \$15-10-5.
- 11. Cl. 2-2 + 2-3, 20 Any size. 10 Arita + 10 Satsuma. Try to include the 4 pictorial sections, a pattern, a verbal and the 3 basic shapes. Twin Valley Button Club in memory of Rita M. Doherty. \$50, 35, 15.
- 12. Cl. 3-4.2 + 3-4.3 + 3-4.4, Small. Calico + Lusters (all lusters) + Stencils. 14 of each class. New York State Button Society in honor of our new President, Kathy Arbogast. \$15-10-5.
- 13. Cl. 5-5.1, Various. Backgrounds assorted. Gretchen Gauthier. \$15-10-5.
- 14. Cl. 7-0, Small. Clear and colored glass assorted specialized to green glass. All hues, tints, and shades of green are acceptable. Label and mount in class order. Gretchen Gauthier. \$15-10-5.
- 15. Cl. 7-0, Various. Colored glass specialized to yellow and amber. No balance between the colors required. Label and mount in class order. Katrina Quirk in honor of Sabrina O'Meara's sunny smile. \$15-10-5.
- 16. Cl. 7-3, 20 Any size. Colored glass specialized to red. Limited to those who have never won a ribbon at NERBA. Massachusetts State Button Society. \$20-20-20.
- 17. Cl. 10-3, 25 Any size. Pewter assorted. Must have 5 each of Battersea, Danforth, and Christina with the remaining 10 buttons of any pewter. Leah Antinick. \$10-7-5.
- 18. Cl. 17-1 through 20-24, 25 Any Size. Pictorials assorted specialized to movies, and buttons representing movies. Label the movie each button represents. Metropolitan Button Club. \$25-15-10.
- 19. Cl. 17-5, 20 Any size. Mammals specialized to mice and rats. No need for balance. Try for a variety of materials. Lynn Keller. \$15-10-5.
- 20. Cl. 17-5.1 + 17-5.2, 25 Any size. Cats (domestic) + Cats (wild). Limit of four studio buttons. Monson Button Club in honor of Regina Schlesinger. \$20-20-20.
- 21. Cl. 17-5.2, 20 Any size. Cats (wild) specialized to 10 tigers and 10 lions. No limit on studios. Nutmeg Button Club in honor of cat lovers everywhere. \$15-10-5.
- 22. Cl. 17-5.3, 25 Any size. Deer family. Must have at least one moose. No balance required between moose and deer. Label type of animal (deer, elk, moose, etc.). Elaine Baur. \$15-10-5.
- 23. Cl. 18-6.2 + 18-12, 20 Any size. Fans + Unlisted specialized to feathers. Try for balance between classes. Stylized fans and feathers not allowed. Label materials. Betty Korostynski. \$20-15-10.
- 24. Cl. 18-6, 25 Any size. Fashion accessories assorted, specialized to 5 of each of purses, belts, shoes, hats, and umbrellas/parasols. New Hampshire State Button Society. \$25-25-10.

- 25. Cl. 20-17 + 20-23, 20 Any size. Men + Women. 10 of each class. Must be real people. No mythological, story characters, or fantasy people allowed. Label the name of the person. Joanne Wyman in honor of everyone who has made NERBA a success. \$25-15-10.
- 26. Cl. 21-7, Various. Pictorial summary specialized to black glass. Linda Goldberg. \$15-10-5.
- 27. Cl. 22-1, 25 Any size. Patterns assorted specialized to fabric. See Blue Book page 23 for list of patterns and labeling requirements. Elaine Baur in honor of Cheryl Killam. \$20-10-5.
- 28. Cl. 23-10.3, 30 Any size. Realistics specialized to shell. Beverly Hesse. \$10-6-4.
- 29. Cl. 23-12, 25 Any size. Unlisted, specialized to buttons that are predominantly green on the face (obverse). Belknap Button Club. \$25-15-10.

People's Choice 2024 Awards

Adult Award, Minimum 25 Any size. Creative button craft award limited to: articles of clothing or accessories that must be wearable such as vest or hat with button craft design applied; wall hangings limited to 3' x 3' size, must be mountable as wall or door hanging; decorative home/yard item for display use only. Use of clothing items okay only if creative design makes item totally unwearable such as a belt glued & twisted together with buttons. Laurel Durso in honor of Sabrina O'Meara. \$25-15-10.

Junior (under 18) Award, Minimum 25 Any size. Creative button craft award limited to: articles of clothing or accessories that must be wearable such as vest or hat with button craft design applied; wall hangings limited to 3' x 3' size, must be mountable as wall or door hanging; decorative home/yard item for display use only on a table or shelf, etc.. Use of clothing items okay only if creative design makes item totally unwearable such as a belt glued & twisted together with buttons. Laurel Durso in honor of Thelma Nichols. \$25-15-10.
