It's time for donning our party hats and placing 40 candles on a birthday cake. NERBA is celebrating our special 40th anniversary in 2024. With the assistance of one of our NERBA founders, Joanne Wyman, and a copy of the first NERBA show program, the following is a nostalgic look back to 1984-85.

Here's "How NERBA Began" from the NERBA Auction Book. To quote Joanne Wyman: "At a November, 1984 Massachusetts State Show a local collector offered a new item for New Business. Wouldn't it be nice if all the members from the New England States could get together and have a button show. No one would step forward to get such an event up and going. But on the ride home, Jane Leslie and I were talking heads: We can do this! For hours on the phone, we plotted and planned (no email back then).

The first Northeast Regional Button Association meeting was held May 31 to June 1, 1985 in a small motel in Chicopee, Massachusetts with about 10 dealers and an enthusiastic crowd from all over New England." It was hosted by MSBS and had a program, "Les Petites Dames de Mode" presented by John Burbridge. The second meeting in 1986 was hosted by CSBS.

The New England regional button show model was inspirational in the starting of two other regional button shows. Way to go NERBA **and** our local button collectors using good old-fashioned "Yankee Ingenuity "!

As a special anniversary treat, show programs and a slideshow of button pictures from the many fun, show-themed evenings will be gathered into a display as a tribute to all the wonderful button friends who made the NERBA shows a success. We have most of the show programs and a few newsletters.
